



STAIN GUIDE

HAND TUFTED RUGS – 100% LINEN

Read below for information about different types of stains and advice on how to remove them. Do not use water or any other liquids on rugs made of 100% linen.

TYPE OF STAIN:	ACTION DO AS FOLLOWS:
All fat-containing products, e.g. asphalt, colouring crayons, lipstick, oil, shoe polish, soot, cream and cooking fat.	Scrape away as much of the stain as possible using a knife, spoon or similar. Do not rub the stain, as it can go deeper into the rug.
Beer, blood, chocolate, colored soda, coffee, egg, fruit, fruit syrup, ice cream, juice, red wine, urine and vomit.	Soak up the liquid using a highly absorbent cloth (e.g kitchen paper, a diaper or a towel). Do not rub the stain, as it can go deeper into the rug.
Chewing gum and candle wax.	Chewing gum: Cool the stain using ice cubes. Scrape up as much of the stain as possible using a knife, spoon or similar, without damaging the fibres. Then vacuum around the stain. Candle wax: Place 4 layers of kitchen paper on the stain and iron at medium heat, so that the paper soaks up the candle wax.
